## **MISSION STATEMENT:**

## **UPCOMING EVENTS:**

**National First Responders Day** on **October 28** recognizes the heroic men and women who make it their business to take immediate action when disaster strikes. Congress designated October 28th as National First Responders Day in 2017. The resolution honors the firefighters, police officers, paramedics/EMTs, medical personnel and all those who are first on the scene in stressful situations. For all church members who are part of the First Responders team, we thank you. When you see a police officer, fireman, EMT, etc., please recognize them and thank them for their service.



**Veterans Day** is coming up on **November 11th**. Veterans Day is a time for us to pay our respects to those who have served. For one day, we stand united in respect for you, our veterans.

This holiday started as a day to reflect upon the heroism of those who died in our country's service and was originally called Armistice Day. It fell on Nov. 11 because that is the anniversary of the signing of the Armistice that ended World War I. However, in 1954, the holiday was changed to "Veterans Day" to account for all veterans in all wars.

Castle Oaks Church will have a special recognition of the men and women who have given the ultimate sacrifice in serving the country at the morning services on November 7th. The USSM ministry will also host a **Meet-and-Greet** between the two services in the church's Café. There will be plenty of donuts available, so grab a cup coffee on your way in. All veterans, active military, and first responders along with their families are welcome to join with the social gathering in the Café.



**Wreaths Across America:** Each December on National Wreaths Across America Day, our mission to Remember, Honor and Teach is carried out by coordinating wreath-laying ceremonies at Arlington National Cemetery, as well as at more than 2,500 additional locations in all 50 U.S. states, at sea and abroad.

This year's ceremony will be on **December 18<sup>th</sup>** at Castle Rock's Cedar Hill Cemetery. The observance will start at 10:00. Please plan to be there early as there is limited parking along with many volunteers. Cedar Hill has over 450 veterans interred in the cemetery. The observance at Cedar Hill Cemetery will be held at the Veterans Memorial gardens at Cedar Hill Cemetery, 880 E. Wolfensberger Road, Castle Rock.

**Christmas Cards for Troops and First Responders:** Like last year when we sent over 80 Christmas cards to active military members, we are planning to exceed that number this year to include First Responders currently working in the Castle Rock community as well as family members within our church. There will be bundles of Christmas cards made available mid-November for all of us to sign and return to the church. Watch the Castle Oaks eNews for information in November.
